## COMPASSIONATE AND COMPELLING CIRCUMSTANCES

Under the terms of the ESOS Act 2014 and the National Code (ESOS) Part D there are several acceptable reasons why a student has been unable to achieve their 80% attendance obligation.

Compassionate or compelling circumstances are generally those beyond the control of the student and which have an impact upon the student's course progress or wellbeing.

These could include, but are not limited to:

- serious illness or injury, where a medical certificate states that the student was unable to attend classes
- bereavement of close family members such as parents or grandparents (Where possible a death certificate should be provided)
- major political upheaval or natural disaster in the home country requiring emergency travel and this has impacted on the student's studies; or
- a traumatic experience which could include:
- involvement in, or witnessing of a serious accident; or
- witnessing or being the victim of a serious crime, and this has impacted on the student (these
  cases should be supported by police or psychologists' reports)
- where the registered provider was unable to offer a pre-requisite unit; or
- inability to begin studying on the course commencement date due to delay in receiving a student visa

## Please consider the above and bring any documentary evidence you can provide.

Documentary evidence could include but is not limited to:

- Doctor's certificate
- Letter from parent or guardian
- Letter from partner or another associated adult
- · News reports of homeland issues
- News reports of crimes experienced
- Reports from police, ambulance and/or fire services
- Statutory Declarations witnessed by a Justice of the Peace\*

Copies of these documents should be archived with this letter in your student file.

Originals should be kept by the student for the purpose of future hearings.

Please note: As per the ESOS Act, failure to comply with this notice (SD C 120), providing false or misleading information (SD C 121), giving a false or misleading document (SD C122) are all criminal offences under the act and may attract harsh penalties.

There is a Justice of the Peace free service at the Downing Centre, 143-147 Liverpool St, Sydney 2000-just 150 metres from the college.
