## DIPLOMA OF BEAUTY THERAPY

### QUALIFICATION DESCRIPTION

This qualification reflects the role of individuals employed as beauty therapists to provide a broad range of beauty therapy treatments and services including facial treatments, body massage and treatments, hair removal, lash and brow treatments, nail and make-up services. This includes consultation with clients to provide beauty advice, recommend beauty treatments and services, and sell retail skincare and cosmetic products.

These individuals work relatively autonomously and are accountable for personal outputs. Their work involves the self-directed application of knowledge and skills with substantial depth in some areas where judgement is required in planning and selecting appropriate equipment, services and techniques. Work is typically conducted in beauty salons and spas.

The skills in this qualification must be applied in accordance with Commonwealth and State or Territory legislation, Australian standards and industry codes of practice.

No occupational licensing, certification or specific legislative requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

### CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates will be able to obtain a range of employment opportunities in areas such as beauty therapist, skincare specialist, nail technician and more. Graduates at this level will apply knowledge and skills to demonstrate autonomy, judgement and defined responsibility.

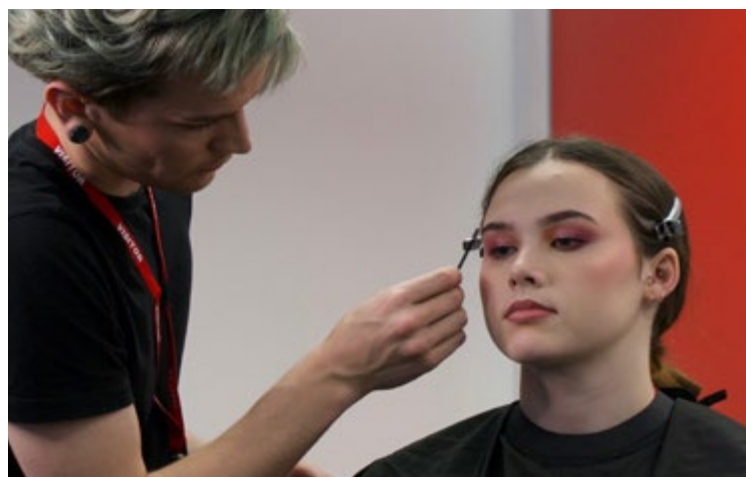
