The Australasia International School employs trainer assessors who work in or have their own businesses in project management. Our students learn the skills and knowledge in today's context as a result, students will learn how to create, manage, meet project goals, to achieve this on time, budget and within the projects scope.

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who apply specialised knowledge and skills, together with experience in program management across a range of enterprise and industry contexts. The job roles that relate to this qualification include Program Manager.

Individuals in these roles are responsible for managing or directing a program to achieve organisational objectives. A program is defined as a set of interrelated projects, each of which has a project manager.

Individuals at this level use initiative and judgement to direct, plan, and lead a range of program functions, with accountability for personal and team outcomes within broad parameters. They use cognitive and communication skills to identify, analyse and synthesise information from a variety of sources and transfer their knowledge to others, and creative or conceptual skills to express ideas and perspectives or respond to complex problems.

Potential employment options are in a range of Project management roles in a range of industry areas. Students who complete this course may wish to continue their education into higher education qualifications in leadership and management.ons in Program/ Project and management.

UNITS

There are 4 Core and 8 Elective units in this course totaling 12 units of study.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT (International Students)

- be a minimum of 18 years of age;
- have completed Year 12 or equivalent;
- successfully completed the AIS Pre-Enrolment Suitability Form; and
- have an IELTS of 5.5 or equivalent score.
- ·have completed one of the following qualifications: BSB50820 Diploma of Project Management; or BSB51415 Diploma of Project Management (or a superseded equivalent version),or
- ·have completed two years equivalent full-time relevant workplace experience at a significant level within a project or program environment within an enterprise.

COURSE COST (Prices may change without notice)

DELIVERY MODE AND DURATION

- **Course duration:** 80 weeks over six (6) Terms
- **Term:** 60 weeks of training and assessment spread over 6 terms of 10 weeks each and 20 weeks of holidays.
- **Weekly Hours:** 20 hours per week during the term
- **Delivery mode:** Classroom, 2 days per week, 8 hours with breaks
Supervised study session: ½ day per week, 4 hours with breaks
Self-paced learning (homework) is 5 hours per week
