The Australasia International School has professionally set up Beauty training rooms and has highly skilled trainers to facilitate this course so that students can learn, be confident and be ready for industry upon successful completion.

COURSE OUTCOMES

This qualification reflects the role of individuals employed as beauticians to provide a range of beauty services including nail, waxing, lash and brow, and basic make-up services.

These individuals possess a range of well-developed technical and customer service skills where discretion and judgement is required and are responsible for their own outputs. This includes client consultation on beauty products and services. Work is typically conducted in beauty, waxing, brow and nail salons.

LICENCING REQUIREMENT

No occupational licensing, certification or specific legislative requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates will be able to obtain a range of employment opportunities in areas such as Beauty Therapist, Skincare Specialist, Nail Technician and more.

THIRD PARTIES

PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites associated with this qualification. Individuals may enter SHB30115 Certificate III in Beauty Services with limited or no vocational experience and without a lower level qualification.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

Domestic Students must:

- be a minimum of 18 years of age;
- have completed Year 12 or equivalent; and
- successfully completed the AIS pre-enrolment suitability form.

International Students must:

- be a minimum of 18 years of age;
- have completed Year 12 or equivalent;
- successfully completed the AIS pre-enrolment suitability form; and
- have an IELTS or equivalent score of 5.5.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING AND CREDIT TRANSFER

Students may apply for recognition of existing qualifications or skills, knowledge, and experience by either Credit Transfer (CT) or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). The granting of course credit may affect course fees as well as the duration of the course.

This process is outlined in Australasia International School Student Enrolment and Completion Policy and Associated Procedures and Training and Assessment Policy & Associated Procedures.

AWARD QUALIFICATION AND OUTCOME

On successful completion of this course students will be awarded a nationally recognised qualification: SHB30115 Certificate III in Beauty Services.

The Certificate III in Beauty Services requires the completion of 15 units of competency including 11 core units and 4 electives.

DELIVERY MODE AND DURATION

- Time to complete: Up to 28 weeks
- Terms: 2 terms
- Each Term: 10 weeks plus a 2 week study break (an extra 4 weeks over the Christmas)
- Delivery: Classroom. Practical face to face training is provided in a clinic.
- Days: 3 days per week, each day is 7 hours with breaks
- Self-paced learning: 5 hours per week
