COURSE OUTCOMES

Graduates will be able to obtain a range of employment opportunities who apply specialised knowledge and skills, together with experience in project management across a range of enterprise and industry contexts.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT – TRAINING PACKAGE

The Training Package itself does not identify entry requirements

ENTRY REQUIREMENT – RTO SPECIFIC

Domestic Students must:

1. be a minimum of 18 years of age
2. have completed Year 12 or equivalent and,
3. successfully completed the AIS pre-course review.

International Students must:

1. be a minimum of 18 years of age,
2. have completed Year 12 or equivalent,
3. Complete the AIS Pre-enrolment suitability form to determine suitability for the course and student needs,
4. Have an IELTS* score of 5.5 or equivalent (test results must be no more than 2 years old).

*Note that other English language tests such as PTE and TOEFL can be accepted. Students are required to provide their results so that it can be confirmed they are equivalent to IELTS 5.5.



RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING AND CREDIT TRANSFER

Students may apply for recognition of existing qualifications or skills, knowledge, and experience by either Credit Transfer (CT) or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). The granting of course credit may affect course fees as well as the duration of the course.

AWARD QUALIFICATION AND OUTCOME

On successful completion of this course students will be awarded a nationally recognised qualification: BSB50820 Diploma of Project Management.
