#### **SHB50115 DIPLOMA OF BEAUTY THERAPY**

The Australasia International School has professionally set up Beauty training rooms and has highly skilled trainers to facilitate this course so that students can learn, be confident and be ready for industry upon successful completion.

#### **COURSE OUTCOMES**

This qualification reflects the role of individuals employed as beauty therapists to provide a broad range of beauty therapy treatments and services including facial treatments, body massage and treatments, hair removal, lash and brow treatments, nail and make-up services. This includes consultation with clients to provide beauty advice, recommend beauty treatments and services, and sell retail skin-care and cosmetic products.

These individuals work relatively autonomously, and are accountable for personal outputs. Their work involves the self-directed application of knowledge and skills with substantial depth in some areas where judgement is required in planning and selecting appropriate equipment, services and techniques. Work is typically conducted in beauty salons and spas.

#### **LICENCING REQUIREMENT**

No occupational licensing, certification or specific legislative requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

#### **CAREER OPPERTUNITIES**

Graduates will be able to obtain a range of employment opportunities in areas such as Beauty Therapist, Skincare Specialist, Nail Technician and more. Graduates at this level will apply knowledge and skills to demonstrate autonomy, judgment, and defined responsibility.

#### **THIRD PARTIES**

Australasia International School has a range of agreements with Third Party Organisations providing recruitment services.

#### **PREREQUISITES**

There are no prerequisites associated with this qualification. Individuals may enter SHB50115 DIPLOMA OF BEAUTY THERAPY with limited or no vocational experience and without a lower level qualification.

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENT**

Domestic Students must:

1. be a minimum of 18 years of age
2. have completed Year 12 or equivalent and,
3. successfully completed the AIS pre-course review.

International Students must:

1. be a minimum of 18 years of age,
2. have completed Year 12 or equivalent,
3. Complete the AIS Pre-enrolment suitability form to determine suitability for the course and student needs,
4. Have an IELTS\* score of 5.5 or equivalent (test results must be no more than 2 years old).

\*Note that other English language tests such as PTE and TOEFL can be accepted. Students are required to provide their results so that it can be confirmed they are equivalent to IELTS 5.5.



## RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING AND CREDIT TRANSFER

Students may apply for recognition of existing qualifications or skills, knowledge, and experience by either Credit Transfer (CT) or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). The granting of course credit may affect course fees as well as the duration of the course.

This process is outlined in Australasia International School Student Enrolment and Completion Policy and Associated Procedures and Training and Assessment Policy & Associated Procedures.

## AWARD QUALIFICATION AND OUTCOME

On successful completion of this course students will be awarded a nationally recognised qualification: SHB50115 Diploma of Beauty Therapy.

The Diploma of Beauty Therapy requires the completion of 25 units of competency including 13 core units and 12 electives.

### DELIVERY MODE AND DURATION

- Time to complete: Up to 80 weeks
- Terms: 6 terms
- Each Term: 10 weeks plus a 2 week study break (an extra 4 weeks over the Christmas)
