SHB50216 DIPLOMA OF SALON MANAGEMENT

COURSE OUTCOMES

This qualification reflects the role of senior managers and small business owners of personal services businesses. They are responsible for coordinating the day-to-day operation of the business and for planning, monitoring and evaluating the work of the team. Salon managers also operate with significant autonomy to make strategic business management decisions.

This qualification provides a pathway to work as a salon manager in any type of personal service business including hairdressing or beauty salons, barber shops and spas.

LICENCING REQUIREMENT

No occupational licensing, certification or specific legislative requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates will be able to work as a salon manager in any type of personal service business including hairdressing or beauty salons, barber shops and spas.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

Entry to this qualification is limited to those who:

- Be at least 18 years of age and have completed Year 12 or equivalent.
- Complete the AIS Pre-enrolment suitability form to determine suitability for the course and student needs.
- Have an IELTS* score of 5.5 or equivalent (test results must be no more than 2 years old).

* Note that other English language tests such as PTE and TOEFL can be accepted. Students are required to provide their results so that it can be confirmed they are equivalent to IELTS 5.5. Entry requirements are confirmed on enrolment prior to the issuance of a Letter of Offer

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING AND CREDIT TRANSFER

Students may apply for recognition of existing qualifications or skills, knowledge, and experience (credit transfer or recognition of prior learning). The granting of course credit may affect course fees as well as the duration of the course. This process is outlined in Australasia International School Student Enrolment and Completion Policy and Associated Procedures and Training and Assessment Policy & Associated Procedures.



AWARD QUALIFICATION AND OUTCOME

On successful completion of this course students will be awarded a nationally recognised qualification: SHB50216 Diploma of Salon Management.

DELIVERY MODE AND DURATION

- Time to complete: 64 weeks
- Terms: 5 terms
