The Australasia International School has professionally set up Beauty training rooms with highly skilled trainers to facilitate this course so that students can learn, be confident and ready for industry upon successful completion.

This qualification reflects the role of individuals employed as beauty therapists to provide a broad range of beauty therapy treatments and services including facial treatments, specialised facials, micro dermabrasion, aromatherapy massage, stone therapy massage, reflexology, body massage, hair removal, lash and brow treatments, nail, and make-up services. This includes consultation with clients to provide beauty advice, recommend beauty treatments and services, and sell retail skincare and cosmetic products.

These individuals work relatively autonomously and are accountable for personal outputs. Their work involves the self-directed application of knowledge and skills with substantial depth areas where judgement is required in planning and selecting appropriate equipment, services, and techniques.

Work is typically conducted in beauty salons and spas.

Potential employment options are in a range of beauty therapists roles in a wide variety of industry areas.

Students who complete this course may wish to continue their education into a range of Advanced Diploma qualifications and Dermal Therapies in Higher Education.



UNITS

There are 20 Core and 9 Elective units in this course totaling 29 units of study.



ENTRY REQUIREMENT (International Students)

- be a minimum of 18 years of age;
- have completed Year 12 or equivalent;
- successfully completed the AIS Pre-Enrolment Suitability Form; and have an IELTS of 5.5 or equivalent score (test results must be no more than 2 years old).

DELIVERY MODE

This program is delivered in the classroom. Practical face to face training is provided initially in the classroom setting and then into the Clinic to work on external paying clients to further develop their treatment skills and complete observation assessments.
